

# 2010 RBSA Umpire Guidelines

## Considerations:

- Umpires Age: The age target should be 3yrs removed from the league they are umpiring.
- Adult/ Cert Umpires: When possible, attempt to have an Adult or Cert Umpire behind the plate for the older age groups. (
  - Pony Baseball & 15U Softball is a “must”
  - American Baseball & 12U Softball is a “high want”
- Home Field Coaches: To provide the game balls, represent the RBSA organization regarding field conditions, etc. and communicate in the pre game meeting.
- Head Coaches: Are responsible to know the league rules, and communicate any “white sheet” rules in the pre game meeting.

## 2010 Umpire Pay Structure:

Note1: Umpires to be paid at the concession stand after each game.

Note 2: Scheduling of the umpires to be performed by the Home Team’s organization.

### Baseball Umpire Fees

- 8U (Midget) Baseball: (1) umpire only = \$20 per game
- 10U (National) Baseball: (2) umpires, Plate = \$20 + Field = \$15 per game (If Cert behind Plate = \$35)
- 12U (American) Baseball: (2) umpires, Plate = \$25 + Field = \$20 per game (If Cert behind Plate = \$35)
- 14U (Pony) Baseball: (2) Umpires, Plate = Cert @ \$40 + Field = \$20 per game

### Softball Umpire Fees

- 8U Softball: (1) umpire only = \$20 per game
- 10U Softball: (1) umpire only = \$25 per game (If Cert = \$35)
- 12U Softball: (1) Cert umpire only = \$35 per game (non-cert = \$30)
- 15U Softball: (1) Cert umpire only = \$40 per game

## Field Preparation & Expectations (\$4.00 per game)

- Drag the field
- Line the field
- Assure proper distances for the bases and pitchers rubber are set.
- Pick-up/ Dump the field’s Trash cans.
